

## **A Parents' Guide to Youth Lectures**

*“Mom and dad, I’ve got to go Dallas. Everybody is going to Youth Lectures and I gotta go too!”*

*“Dallas!?! Youth Lectures? What is that?”*

At this time of year this scenario is repeated in homes all over Texas and surrounding states. Every year the Westside church’s Youth Lectures attract more and more young people (and families) with the result that more and more kids hear about what a great event it is. Unfortunately, sometimes parents are not quite as “filled in” about the Lectures and so may even be reluctant to let their children attend. That is why we created this Parent’s Guide to Youth Lectures!

### ***Youth Lectures? What is it?***

In a few words, it is a weekend Gospel meeting. That is probably the easiest way to describe it. Youth Lectures is a biblically authorized effort on the part of the Westside church to proclaim the Gospel in accord with Matthew 28:18-20, 1 Thessalonians 1:8 and a host of other verses that command the church to preach and teach God’s Word.

On Friday night there will be a half hour of singing, followed by preaching on that year’s Lecture theme. There will be two speakers, one right after another.

On Saturday afternoon we will have the same kind of service: a half hour of singing and two sermons. After the closing prayer we ask any who wish to stay for singing to remain. There is then an hour-long singing Saturday afternoon. Since services begin at 1:00 on Saturday that means those who stay for the singing get out around 4:15-4:30 p.m.

On Sunday morning we will finish out Lectures with a sermon during the Bible class hour (presented by one of our elders) and then our preacher, Mark Roberts, will preach during the worship hour. That service concludes the Lectures, and usually is over by 11:00 a.m.

That means in less than three days your child (and you too, if you come) will sing for two and a half hours and hear six hours of Gospel preaching! It is an incredible weekend because it packs so much spiritual edification, worship and Bible study into a short time.

### ***Is this some sort of social gospel, fun and games deal?***

Absolutely not. The Westside church takes a very strong stand against liberalism regarding the church’s God-given work. We do not believe it is the function of the New Testament church to provide social and recreational opportunities for young people and have no intention of ever doing that kind of thing. Youth Lectures is about building up people in the Word of God as Paul commanded in Acts 20:32.

That said, surely many of the kids arrange *own their own* to visit and socialize before and after services at various restaurants and in homes. That is, of course, their prerogative and is something that can and should be done by *individual Christians*. But again, the point of Lectures is to help young people learn from God's Word. It is not a church sponsored social by any stretch of the imagination. It is just a Gospel meeting that targets its teaching to young people.

***Sounds like a great weekend. Can parents come?***

Absolutely! We would love for you to attend. Many, many parents, and even Christians without kids in the audience, will come to worship and hear powerful preaching. Please come along!

***Where do the kids who come from out of town stay?***

Most kids stay with friends in private homes. Some elect to stay in motels. If you do not know anyone to stay with and need housing we have several families here who would be glad to house you and your family. **Please let us know well in advance, however, so that we can make proper arrangements.**

If you wish to stay in a hotel the Main Stay Suites is the hotel located directly across the street from the church building. Their address is 2323 Imperial Drive in Irving. Their phone number is (972) 257-5400 Often they offer a special rate for Youth Lectures so you might ask for the "Westside rate" when you make reservations. Other close hotels include the Hampton Inn, Amerisuites and Holiday Inn. If you are looking on the Internet for reservations look for hotels on the south end of DFW Airport in Irving that are close to Beltline or Esters Road on Hwy 183 (the Airport Freeway).

***Where is Westside located?***

We are right in the heart of the DFW Metroplex, in Irving. The building is right off the main artery, Highway 183. See our website or the flyer for a more detailed map.
